Dear Friends,

It's 100 years since Pope Benedict XV's encyclical *Maximum Illud*. It signalled a new journey to understanding more fully the 'momentous call' of the Lord to 'go into the whole world and preach the Gospel to all creation' (Mk 16:15). In commemoration, Pope Francis has declared October to be an Extraordinary Month of Mission. This special month of prayer and action calls us all to renew our missionary commitment by sharing the Good News of Jesus with all people.
