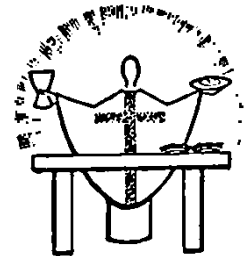

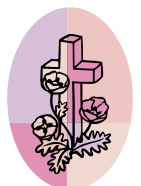

## The Butterfly
