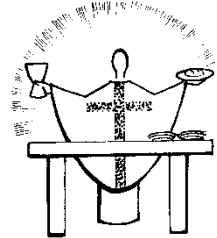

Dear Parishioners of Castlebar,

On behalf of the families and communities who benefit from your generosity, I would like to offer a heartfelt thank you for your generous support of this year's Trócaire Lenten campaign - €19,160.

Your support this Lent with help Kumba, aged 8, and her family and local community in Freetown, Sierra Leone to have a brighter future. You will remember that last August more than 1,000 people from this community lost their lives in a mudslide and thousands more were left homeless. This includes:

- **Counselling and support** for survivors to address the trauma they have suffered, especially for children who have lost their families.
- **Emergency 'Dignity' Kits** with essential hygiene and household equipment such as soap, sanitary items and kitchen items to help families start again.
- **Two new schools are being built:** Because of your support this Lent two brand new schools are being built to replace those that were destroyed. Kumba and her brother and sisters will attend one of these new schools. Your generosity has also supplied new school books, stationery and uniforms.

Trócaire supporters help to change lives around the world. Last year the generosity of our supporters helped to bring support to 2.8 million of the world's poorest and most vulnerable people. Examples of our impact around the world include:

- Over 190,000 people in Somalia have access to healthcare.
- Over 60,000 people in Malawi were supported to increase food production.
- Almost 40,000 people in Myanmar were provided with shelter, food and humanitarian aid.

Thank you once again for your continued support and generous donations over the last number of months. You are transforming lives and helping the poorest and most vulnerable in our world to prepare for and survive humanitarian disasters such as floods, hurricanes, earthquakes, droughts and conflict and to tackle the injustices which many face every day.
