

Update from Castlebar's NET Team

As Easter is approaching, we are busier now than ever...

We continue to work in all eight primary schools in Castlebar each week. Continuing to prepare the students for their upcoming Confirmation, we've gone over different topics including Jesus' Love, Sainthood, and what Confirmation really is. The primary school classes are one of our favourite parts of our ministry!

We also host several events outside of the schools. We meet with students in Youth Serve (3-6th Years) and our Junior Youth Group (1-2 Years) each week. During these events students have an opportunity to grow in their faith and have a great time together.

During the second week of March, we were blessed to have a group of college students come from the U.S. to help us in our mission. While they were here, we spent time with GMIT students at their nearby accommodation centre. We had loads of events which allowed us to meet the students there. It has opened a door for us with college-age students and we now host a weekly Bible Study with them.

On the second Sunday of every month we have an event called 'Disciple Night'. From 4-8pm young people from all over Connaught come together for faith, food and fun. Each night has a powerful talk, Adoration, Holy Mass, and loads of fun. Disciple Night is a great chance for young adults to meet others who are in their faith. The first three Disciple Nights have been incredible and we are really looking forward to the ones to come.
