

NET Team Update

The first half of this year has been so beautiful and so fruitful. We have been busy with ministry and are really getting to know our youth. We have been able to see Jesus work in so many of their lives and it's been such a gift.

We have been in all the primary schools in Castlebar, going to the sixth class classes and helping them to prepare for their Confirmation later this school year. In the classes we have been teaching the students about the Rosary and the ways we can learn about Jesus and Mary through the mysteries. Recently we started a youth group for the sixth class, giving them an opportunity to learn more about their faith in a different setting.

For our secondary students, we have been having a regular meeting every week and more youth are coming each week.
