## THE SEASON OF CREATION (SEPTEMBER 1st - OCTOBER 4TH)

It began in the most unlikely of places: with a teenager refusing to go to school. But over the last year, a remarkable wave of climate activism has spread across the globe, inspired by the Swedish teenager, Greta Thunberg, who caught the imagination of teenagers around the world, including here in Ireland. Their 'climate strike' gave many older people hope, when it brought thousands of teenagers out on to the streets of towns and cities around Ireland, as they demanded a different ecological future.

Earlier this year, Pope Francis met with Greta Thunberg. He encouraged her to continue her work and assured her that the climate strikes had his support. The Pope sees that care for our world is not just one more good deed that we might choose to take up, but is integral to Christian faith. He insists that as 'we come together to take charge of this home which has been entrusted to us,' we are not responding to some temporarily 'hot' topic in the culture, nor are we motivated by selfish self-interest because of the threat we face. Rather, we care for the earth because we know 'that all the good which exists here will be taken up into the heavenly feast' (LS 244). Our ecological mandate is an eschatological mission!
