## Reading and Explanation of the Word of God

When the Sacred Scriptures are read in the Church, God himself speaks to his people, and Christ, present in his word, proclaims the Gospel.

Therefore, the readings from the Word of God are to be listened to reverently by everyone, for they are an element of the greatest importance in the liturgy. Although in the readings from Sacred Scripture the Word of God is addressed to all people of whatever era and is understandable to them, a fuller understanding and a greater efficaciousness of the word is nevertheless fostered by a living commentary on the word, that is, by the Homily, as part of the liturgical action.

#### FORMS OF FRIDAY PENANCE

The following are suggested as ways of fulfilling Friday penance:

- \* Abstaining from meat or some other food;
- \* Abstaining from alcoholic drink or smoking;
- \* Making a special effort at involvement in family prayer;
- \* Visiting the Blessed Sacrament;
- \* Making the Stations of the Cross:
- \* Fasting from all food for a longer period than usual and perhaps giving what is saved to the needy;
- \* Helping the poor, sick, old or lonely.
