## **Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Gospel: Luke 19:1-10** 

#### Salvation to this house

The story of Zacchaeus is one of the most familiar gospel stories, although it is only found in Luke. The vivid details easily resonate with us: the unpopular tax collector, too short to see Jesus, who climbs a tree to get a better view, and then hears the startling words of Jesus, 'Zacchaeus, hurry and come down; for I must stay at your house today'. As he often does, Jesus goes against the social and religious expectations of his time. As a tax collector, Zacchaeus would have been considered unclean and unworthy, a sinner. While this already makes him an outsider, in this scene he is also literally on the outside of the crowd. He can't get a glimpse of Jesus, but in his determination to see him he climbs a tree.

Jesus sees Zacchaeus, however, and approaches him, creating shock among the onlookers. They grumble, unhappy to see Jesus reaching out to a 'sinner'. Then Jesus does something completely unexpected. He invites himself to Zacchaeus' home, where Jesus' pronouncement is equally unexpected, 'Today, salvation has come to this house'. This story ties in perfectly with the earlier parables of the Lost Coin, the Lost Sheep and the Prodigal Son (Lk 15:1-32). There we are reminded of the rejoicing that takes place when what has been lost is found again. Jesus has come to save the lost.

In this story, it is significant that Jesus invites Zacchaeus into table fellowship, even before he decides to mend his ways and make restitution to those he has cheated. Zacchaeus welcomes Jesus to his house with open arms, and the experience of Jesus' love and acceptance transforms him. Jesus is waiting for our welcome today.
