For Mission Sunday 2023, Pope Francis has chosen the theme inspired by the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus in the Gospel of St Luke (Lk 24:13-35): "Hearts on Fire, Feet on the Move". The two disciples were confused and dismayed, but their encounter with Christ sparked in them the enthusiastic desire to set out again towards Jerusalem and proclaim that the Lord has truly risen. In the Gospel account, we perceive this change in the disciples through a few revealing images: their hearts burned within them as they heard the Scriptures explained by Jesus, their eyes were opened as they recognised him and, ultimately, their feet set out on the way.
